In clinical practice, Dr. Zhang is an expert in standardized treatment of advanced gastric cancer and nutrition support for cancer patients. She participated in formulation of several relevant national and international guidelines, including the National Health Commission standards for diagnosis and treatment of gastric cancer, Chinese Society of Clinical Oncology (CSCO) clinical practice guideline for gastric cancer, CSCO consensus on nutrition support for cancer patients, ESPEN guidelines on nutrition in cancer patients, Chinese expert consensus on enteral and parenteral nutrition support for elderly patients, etc.

Dr. Zhang also engages in clinical and translational research to deal with issues in clinical practice, especially for advanced gastric cancer, and have participated in over a dozen of international and domestic multi-center clinical trials. As the local PI, she is now leading implementation of several phase II and III clinical trials on first- and second-line treatment for gastric cancer. As the coordinator, she is in charge of the design, implementation, quality control and evaluation of a large-sample multi-center phase III randomized trial (PACC of advanced gastric cancer) and two large-scale domestic multi-center phase III randomized trials (RESOLVE and RESOLVE2 for locally advanced gastric cancer). She is also on the team of a key project of Beijing "Study on optimization of surgery and post-operation adjuvant therapy scheme for elderly gastric cancer patients". These clinical trials will greatly contribute to improve individualized medical treatment for gastric cancer patients in China and are expected to upgrade the concept and mode of comprehensive treatment for locally advanced gastric cancer through solid evidence.
